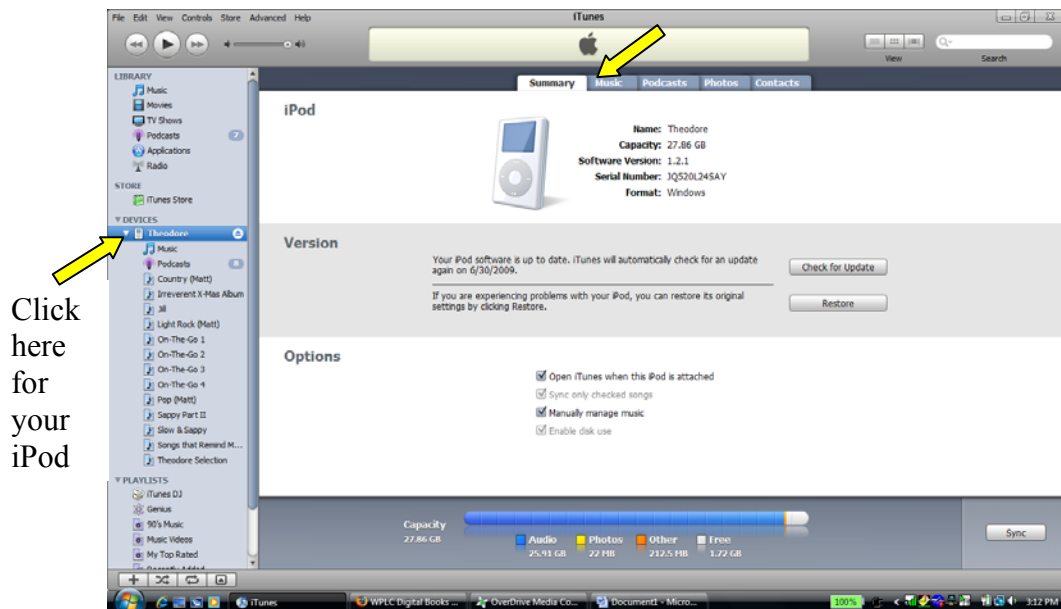
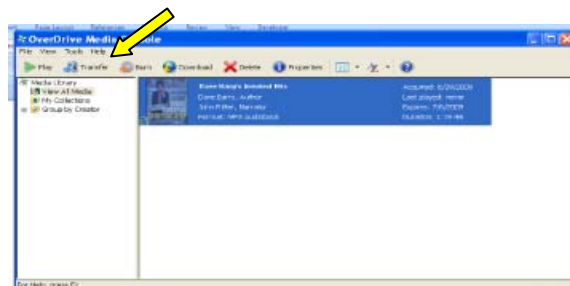

2. Upgrade to iTunes® version 7.6.2.9 (or newer) and QuickTime® v7.4.5 (or newer) if you haven't already done so. <http://www.apple.com/itunes/download/>
3. While the book is downloading, open iTunes & enable manual syncing.
 1. Connect your iPod to your computer.
 2. When the iPod icon appears in the iTunes window (below Devices), select it.
 3. Click the Summary tab to choose between automatic syncing and **manually managing** your music and video:
 4. Click "Apply" if necessary

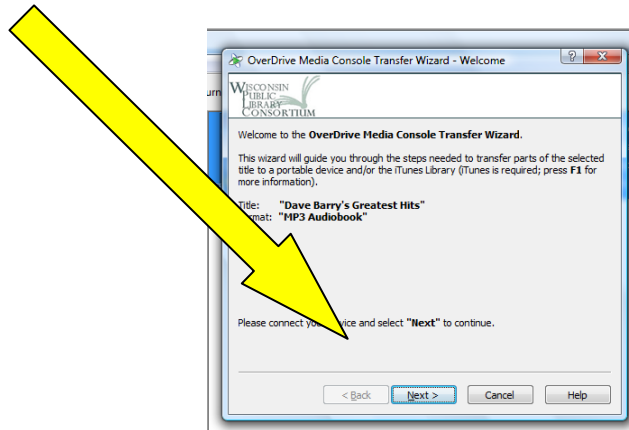
Note: Some options shown might not appear, depending on the type of iPod you have.



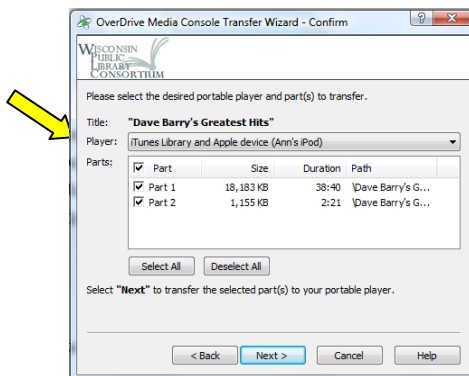
4. After download is complete, the Overdrive Media Console Transfer Wizard will open.
