The Racine Public Library, 75 Seventh St., is taking registration for its next series of Introductory Computer classes. The library offers free, five-week training classes that cover Computer Basics, Internet Basics, Internet Searching, Email Basics, and Word 2010. Classes meet once a week for two hours in the Library's computer lab. Classes are limited to 8 students, so registration is required. Classes are taught by Adult Services Department staff and are open to people of all ages. No previous computer experience is necessary, but library cards are required. These hands-on workshops use computers obtained through grants provided by the Racine Community Foundation, the Colonel L.C. Christensen Charitable and Religious Foundation, and the Friends of the Racine Public Library.
